# Lenten Meditations

## Apostles' Creed

During this third week of Lent, those preparing for full membership in the Church are usually presented with a copy of the Apostles' Creed (or the Nicene Creed), which they are to memorize. It is done publicly because this is viewed as a "passing on" of the faith. This ritual dates back to the early Church. During Lent 387 A.D., St. Augustine followed the same ritual.

Various creeds were used for catechetical instruction as early as the second century. Gradually one fixed form developed which, because of its early origins is called the Apostles' Creed. It is part of the Baptismal Rite.
