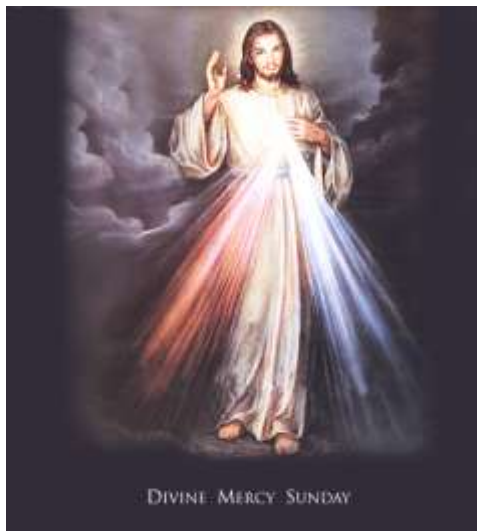

Divine Mercy Sunday

Adoration and Divine Mercy Prayers & Devotions
will be held at 3 p.m. TODAY

**There will be no regular Sunday Evening Adoration
from 6pm to 7pm just for this evening.**

...Pope John Paul II proclaimed: *"it is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the word of God on this Second Sunday of Easter, which from now on throughout the Church, will be called Divine Mercy Sunday."*

By the words "the whole message," the Holy Father was referring to the strict connection between the "Easter Mystery of the Redemption"—the suffering, death, burial, resurrection, and Ascension of Christ, followed by the sending of the Holy Spirit—and this Feast of Divine Mercy, the Octave Day of Easter. This feast adds so much more meaning to the Easter celebrations. It was Jesus, Himself who asked for it to be celebrated on this particular Sunday following Easter.

Our Lord Jesus said, "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet....Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy." (699...Sr. Faustina's diary)

This devotion teaches us what the Church has always taught through scripture and tradition: that God is merciful and forgiving and that we, too, must show mercy and forgiveness. *Remember the ABC message:*

- A: **Ask for His Mercy.** God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world.
- B: **Be merciful.** God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us.
- C: **Completely trust in Jesus.** God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive.

There are two scriptural verses that we should keep in mind as we involve ourselves in these devotional practices:

1. "This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me" (Is 29:13)
2. Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy: (Mt 5:7)
